Course Description: MEDIA522

The course tackle issues of European and national policies for vulnerable groups such as youth, unemployed, women, refugee and migrants, and ethnic minorities with a specific resentation on Roma integration, homeless people, children, and social policy for the elderly.

Specific reference is made to the European Pilar for Social Rights, the European policy on asylum and migration, the Employment policies, and the social policy for fighting poverty. It also focuses on the policy measures during the pandemic crisis in Europe and in third countries. Social Policies and how the different measures for the above-mentioned vulnerable groups are represented in the Media is another important dimension of the course.
